

FAQ: What's the difference between YWCA membership and HPS/Nautilus membership?

ywca

yearly cost: \$25 (Member), \$20 (Associate)

eligibility: Any woman or girl age 12+ (Member)
Any man or boy age 12+ (Associate)

benefits: 100% tax deductible membership fees. Members and Associates must pledge to support the YWCA's mission and programs. Gives Members voting rights at YWCA annual meetings.

yearly cost: \$432 (Single), \$672 (Family), \$360 (Senior)

eligibility: All ages and genders eligible. See application for definitions of "Family" & "Senior."

benefits: Use of all Nautilus fitness facilities (YWCA, Kanawha City, CAMC, & Cross Lanes). Includes aerobic, fitness and aquatic classes. Personal training available for an extra fee.
